



Aim of the Course



Oral rehabilitation with implant-supported prosthesis has become a common treatment for partial or complete edentulism.

However, the placement of implants in an optimal position is frequently compromised due to atrophy of the alveolar process.

Therefore, alveolar ridge augmentation and soft tissue grafting are often necessary to improve long-term implant success.

This comprehensive implant course will provide participants with the current knowledge of various techniques for alveolar ridge augmentation and soft tissue grafting as well as treatment alternatives to minimize morbidity associated with established harvesting procedures.
